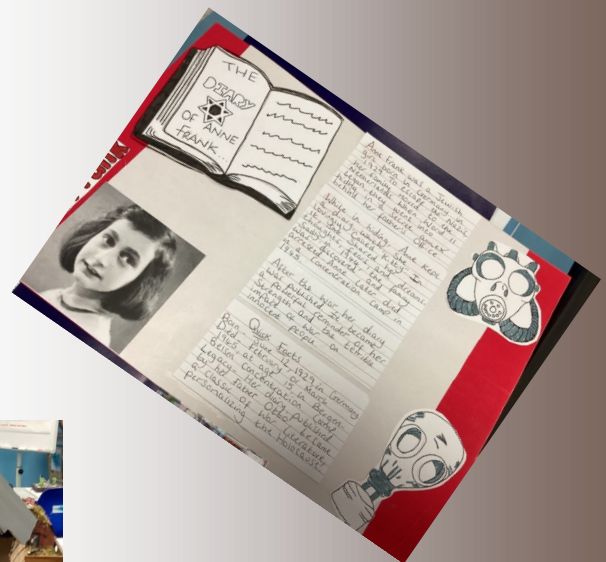
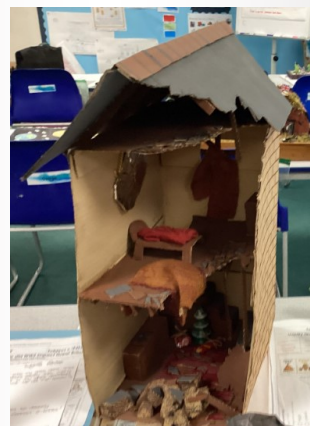
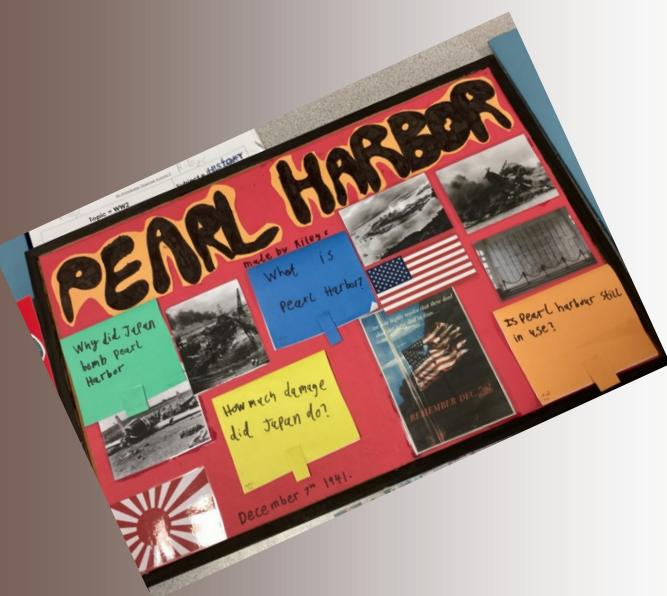
They were given gifts and had lunch on the train. It was a magical trip and the children all behaved beautifully. They all represented the school fantastically. Here's some photos of lots of happy children!

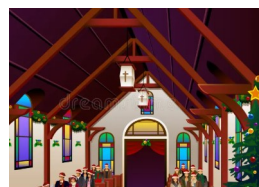
Children are welcome to wear a jumper or Christmas accessory such as hair band, t-shirt or even Christmas socks.
