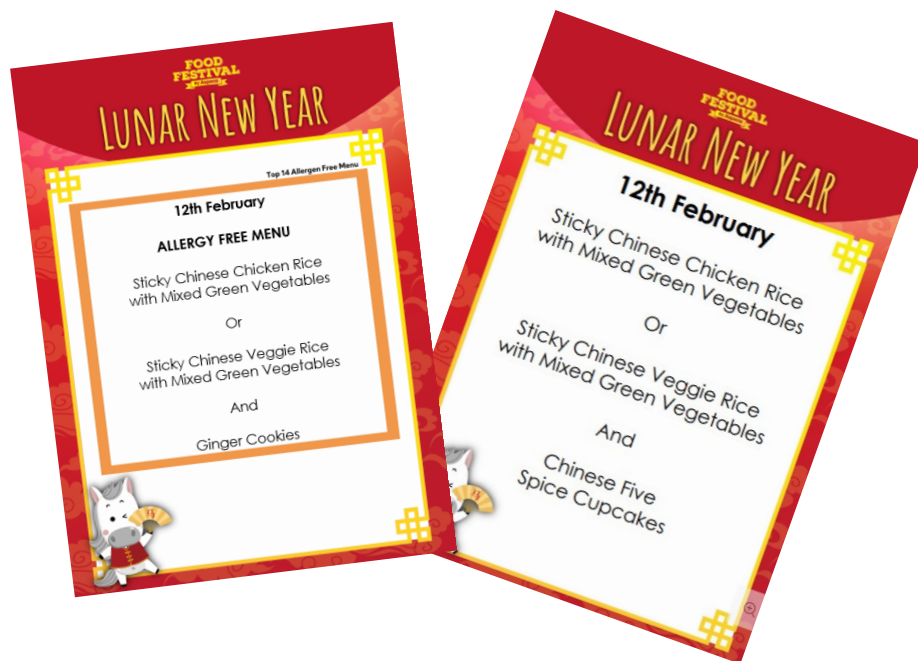
Year 6

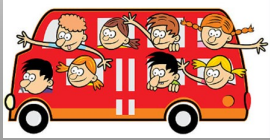

Winner

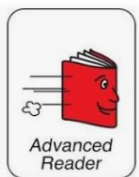
Josie created a fantastic design and was crowned the winner! The design was chosen by our rugby coach, Neil. Well done, Josie!

It's been a fantastic week in the classroom Year 2.

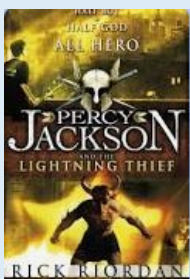


Congratulations
